

It's tough to pick a winner in one race...but if you can pick the winner over an entire year, you could win \$250!

The 7th race at Wautoma last year was the start of something very special for one racehorse. Owner Jim Springer of Livingston, Wisconsin brought his filly ***A PATCHY FROST*** to the Waushara County Fair and driver Ben Gald crossed the finish line first in a time of 2:11.0 for that filly's first win. Since then, ***A PATCHY FROST*** has gone on to race in Chicago and on the East Coast, winning 13 more times and earning \$82,744. Before taking this summer off, she won on May 29 at the Meadowlands in New Jersey, the premier harness track in the United States. Hall of Fame driver John Campbell guided ***A PATCHY FROST*** around that one-mile track in a blistering 1:51.2.

In recognition of her success, the Wisconsin Harness Horse Association (WHHA) is sponsoring a contest to find this year's best horse at the Waushara County Fair! It's pretty straight forward. Read through this race program and select the one horse that you think will earn the most purse money between now and July 31, 2010 and you could win the grand prize of \$250. With a crowd this big, it's likely that many folks will pick the same horse. A random drawing of those winners will determine the Grand Prize Winner, with all other winners receiving a consolation prize. Sit back, study the program, pick your winner using the official entry form attached and follow the monthly standings at www.wiharnessracing.com. ***Good luck!***

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

1. No entry fee and very little "fine print"—have fun with it!
2. Entries must be on the official entry form, and must be received by WHHA by 3 p.m. today. PLEASE print clearly; if WE can't read it, YOU can't win.
3. Horse owners, trainers, and drivers (and immediate families) with a horse racing today are not eligible.
4. One entry per person, one horse per entry. You can pick any one horse entered in today's races.
5. Anyone picking the horse that wins the most purse money between (and including) today, August 16, 2009 and July 31, 2010 shall be declared a "winner."
6. A random drawing shall be held during the races at the 2010 Waushara County Fair to determine one Grand Prize Winner (\$250) from all winning entries. The winner must be present to claim the Grand Prize. All other winners shall receive a consolation prize, regardless of attendance.
7. If, for some reason, there is no harness racing during the 2010 fair (bad weather, etc.) the random drawing shall take place on or about the date of the scheduled races by WHHA officials and all prizes shall be awarded.
